

REVERSAL PROCEDURES FOR DIRECT DEPOSIT

If you have an ACH payment that needs to be reversed, you must do the following:

- 1. Complete a reversal form for direct deposit.
- 2. Enter a Cash Receipt in wvOASIS using deposit location #00711.
- 3. Fax the Direct Deposit Reversal form to the WVSTO at 304-340-1509.
- All reversal requests must be received within five business days after the payment's settlement date. Any reversal request submitted on the fifth day must arrive in the Treasurer's Office by Noon.

Reversal - A request attempting to have money returned from the bank. In this case the payment has or will go to the bank and a debit must be sent to the bank in an attempt to have the money returned. If there is sufficient funds in the account the bank will return the money. For this type of request there is no guarantee the money will be returned.
